

Property Checklist to Join the Knox County Goes Native Initiative

It's easier than you think to start going native and attracting wildlife! Use this simple checklist to confirm your property is on its way:

Planning/Assessing Your Property: Choose at least one of the following:
\square Complete a plant inventory of your property
$\hfill \square$ Write/draw a plan to increase the amount of native plants on your property and add wildlife friendly elements
Increasing Native Plants/Reducing Invasive Plants: Choose at least one of the following:
☐ Plant a native species
\square Plant a keystone plant species (see keystone plant list)
$\hfill\square$ Remove an invasive plant -or- participate in a public invasive plant removal project
Encouraging Wildlife: Choose at least one of the following:
\square Add a water feature (e.g. bird bath, rain garden, pond, etc.)
\square Add a shelter feature (e.g. brush pile, bird/bat box, bee hotel, log pile, etc.)
